S. Kalpna Solanki  Chief Executive Officer's Report  IT project almost complete, it is the biggest in EOCP history. It is on budget and will provide accurate and timely information for Operators.  We are asking Operators to log in to their profiles and update the email address to their own unique work or personal email address.  New classification models will be out in September 2017. We have worked with several municipalities to test the model, and feedback has been positive.  Phase one of the Water Workforce Strategies Project is complete. We are looking at starting the implementation phase, which will involve a Water Workforce Commission, involving three credentialing organizations: EOCP, ASTTBC, and APEGBC.  Phase one of the Competency Framework is complete. This project is the first of its kind, it is a Made-in-BC model, that is by Operators, for Operators.
