DIRECT RESPONSIBLE CHARGE (DRC)

DRC is a requirement for all four disciplines:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Level III exams - Operators are required to have 2 years (3,000 hours) of direct responsible charge (DRC) experience in a Class II or higher facility.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Level IV exams - Operators are required to have 2 years (3,000 hours) of direct responsible charge (DRC) experience in a Class III or higher facility.

How to gain DRC?

DRC experience may be gained when an operator has daily on-site responsibility for the operation of a facility/system. In larger facilities/systems, it has been interpreted to mean having daily on-site responsibility for the operation of a major segment of the facility/system.
